

Lafayette School Corporation to close Monday

LAFAYETTE, Ind. – Lafayette School Corporation, Tippecanoe School Corporation and the West Lafayette Community School Corporation will be closed beginning Monday, March 16 to help prevent the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19). The three school superintendents reached this decision together after considering information from the Governor’s Office, the Indiana Department of Education, and the Tippecanoe County Health Department.

All three school districts will observe an extended spring break and resume classes April 1 using remote learning instructional delivery methods. Spring Break for students will commence on March 16 and continue through March 30. Remote learning will be conducted beginning March 31 and continue through at least April 3. Each district will communicate with their families to provide more information regarding this plan.

The school superintendents will continue to monitor the situation and evaluate this plan. An update will be provided to families prior to April 3.
